

Leprechaun Sock Gnomes MARCH 8 1:30PM-3:00PM



Supplies (amounts are for 1 standard gnome)

- 1 white athletic sock & 1 St. Patrick's Day themed ankle sock
- 1 mini St. Patrick's Day hat
- 2 cups rice, bath salts, or beans
- Glue gun, glue dots, or craft glue & scissors & scissors
- 1 small square orange faux fur (or a fur pom pom)
- Small wooden ball (gnome's nose)
- 1 rubber band and 1 hair tie
- 1 square of green felt or 1 felt shamrock (gnome's feet)
- Acrylic paint (any color, for the nose)

Additional supplies (for accents – braids, pipe, toboggan hat, etc...)

- 1 St. Patrick's Day themed knee sock
- 1 candle snuffer (gnome's pipe) + gold acrylic paint
- Shamrock tinsel or garland (to fill the pipe)
- 6 bendable hair curlers
- Orange hair (from a St. Patrick's Day hairband)
- Small amount of batting (or fabric scraps)
- 3-4 buttons, small shamrocks, or other accessories

Clay Pot Leprechaun Hat MARCH 15 1:30PM-3:00PM



Supplies

- 1 terra cotta pot w/base
- 1 small picture frame (fake gold or silver works well)
- Acrylic paint – green and black
- Paint brushes or sponges
- 1 large square floral foam
- Assorted silk flowers
- Tissue paper or fake moss
- Glue gun, craft glue, or glue dots



Instructions

1. Paint the pot and the base to resemble a hat (green with a black “belt”)
2. Turn the pot upside down and glue to the base
3. Glue the picture frame to the center of the “belt” to make a “buckle”
4. Trim the floral foam to fit the top of the pot
5. Glue the floral foam piece to the pot
6. Use the floral foam to secure flowers to top of the centerpiece
7. Use tissue paper or fake moss to cover the floral foam

“Hello Spring!” Wreath MARCH 22 1:30PM-3:00PM



Supplies

- 1 foam wreath base
- Assorted silk flowers
- 3-4 feet of any fabric strips, ribbon, burlap, etc... to wrap the wreath (can be upcycled fabric scraps)
- “Hello Spring” paper template
- Circular piece of cardboard, balsa wood, jar lid, etc...2”-3” diameter
- 4-5 straight pins
- Contrasting ribbon or fabric for hanger (12”)
- Hot glue, craft glue or glue dots, scissors, wire cutters



Instructions

1. Wrap fabric, ribbon or burlap strips to cover entire wreath form – using straight pins to anchor pieces.
2. Color “Hello Spring” paper and glue to circular piece of wood or cardboard
3. Arrange flowers and glue to wreath
4. Attach ribbon or fabric hanger to top of wreath
