



STAY INFORMED PLEASE READ: PCC NEW OPERATING PROTOCOLS

As we reopen, our main concern is the safety and well-being of our visitors, members, volunteers, and staff. PCC is implementing the following protocols because we want to get back to center activities and visit and have a good time while ensuring we all stay well.

PCC will continue to monitor PA State Health Department and local Allegheny County Health Department guidelines. We will inform our members if operations or standards change. As we fully open, we will limit the number of people attending events in various rooms, and we have new operating hours to accommodate for additional cleaning.

Upon your first visit, you will complete the Return to Center Checklist. From July to September, we will conduct temperature checks as you enter the building. If your temperature exceeds 100.4 degrees, you will not be allowed entry to the building even if you are fully vaccinated.

New operations checklist:

- Pre-registration is encouraged for PCC activities, including information & referral, scheduled events (craft classes, book club, poetry group, caregivers’ meetings, etc.).
- Congregant lunches will not resume at this time. However, you may bring your lunch or purchased individual snacks and drinks.
- If you need lunch due to food insecurity or inability to prepare meals, please speak with PPC staff and arrange a grab-and-go lunch.
- If you are not feeling well, please stay home.
- If you are not vaccinated, you are required to properly wear a mask for your safety and the safety of others. Proof of vaccination is not needed. We work on the honor system.
- Hand washing or using the hands-free sanitizing stations at arrival and departure is encouraged.
- Please be responsible for sanitizing your area – tables, chairs, fitness equipment, books, TV remote, etc. Sanitizers and cleaning products will be readily available.
- Visitors are not permitted in offices (without an appointment) or kitchen areas (volunteers are allowed based on staff approval).

- Updates to PCC policies will be communicated in person, via direct mail, email, and the website.
